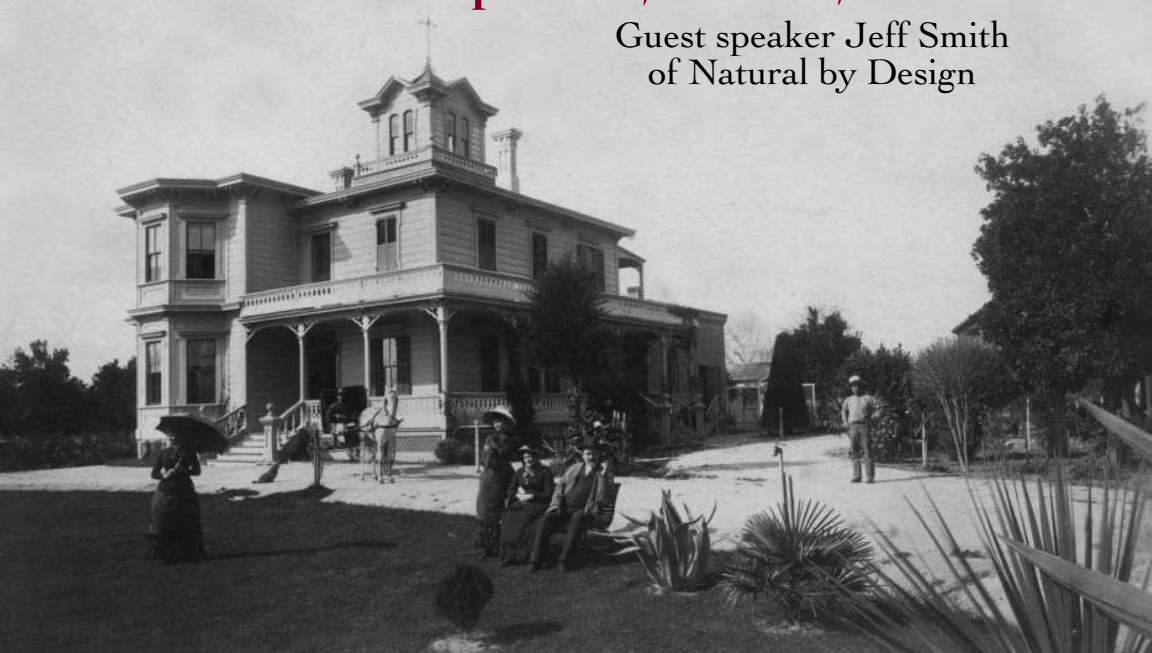


California Landscape: Past, Present, and Future
